



2026 REDCOAT ALUMNI BAND DAY FACT SHEET

(Updated 09-06-26)

Performing HALFTIME (NOT Pregame) Sat. Sept. 12 vs. Western Kentucky. 12:30 broadcast on the SEC Network with 12:45 kickoff time. Free parking will be available in the Intramural Fields parking deck, Lot S-26, and likely Field #8 (the baseball field adjacent to Redcoat Field, subject to weather conditions).

Call time is 6:00 am at Redcoat Field; downbeat for rehearsal is 7:00. **We will NOT be providing breakfast, nor bottled water this year.** Please be prompt, as check-in will include white shirt distribution, borrowed large brass and percussion (if reserved prior to registration close) and other tasks. Rehearsal concludes at 8:30 and shuttle buses will depart from the IM Deck at 8:50 for the Stadium. **Please HYDRATE! Start early with the water/sports drinks – if you wait until you're thirsty, it may be too late.** Bring a water bottle- the water fountain at Redcoat Field gets quite cold after you run it for about 10 seconds.

Tickets purchased through the RBAA have all been transferred. Be sure to save to your Apple Wallet or Google Pay to be scanned at the gates. ALL entering the stadium must have a digital ticket on your phones (even babies).

Concessions inside Sanford are cashless, so don't forget a credit card if you wish to make any purchases. You are permitted one 20 oz. unopened bottle of water into the stadium. Yeti and Stanley cups, etc. are not permitted.

We have been granted permission to wear BLACK shorts as an alternative to long black pants. Short MUST be tasteful and a conservative length (think mid-thigh). Any deviations of this dress code may result in refusal by security to enter the field for halftime. Socks and footwear must be black. You might want to wear your red RBAA polo and change when you get your white t-shirt; the white shirts must be worn for the halftime performance. 2026 field passes must also be displayed (issued at check-in). NOTE: The distribution, etc. for white shirts are for musicians - Auxiliaries will be working with Ashley and Amanda on their dress requirements and details.

We welcome walkups! However, remember there is a limited number of shirts and field passes. No large brass or percussion loaners are available to walkups. Just be sure you have a game ticket for everyone in your party- even babies.

Handicapped seating, if needed, must be handled directly by you with the Ticket Office AFTER you get your tickets:
