

UGA VS. WESTERN KENTUCKY ALUMNI BAND DAY

(as of 09-06-26 subject to updates)

Lot E-01 is now a paid parking lot. Members who drive to Redcoat Field are advised to utilize the Intramural Fields Parking Deck, Lot S-26 (the newer lot at the top of the steps and ends at the driveway by the restrooms). Alumni may also use Field #8 adjacent to Redcoat Field, conditions permitting.

Breakfast and water bottles WILL NOT be provided this year, so please make your own arrangements for food, and HYDRATE! Start on the water and sports drinks early in the day! It'll be an early and long day, and likely a hot one - we care about your well-being! One 20 oz. unopened water bottle may be taken into the Stadium (refill stations are available inside the stadium). For the morning rehearsal, there is a water fountain at Redcoat Field. The water gets quite cold after you run it for about 10 seconds.

Other than instrument cases, which will be searched upon entry, the Clear Bag policy applies.

Sanford Stadium is cashless, so bring a credit card for concessions, merchandise, etc.

• **Alumni Band Halftime:** The 52nd Annual Redcoat Alumni Band will be performing halftime. The only current band members required to be at the morning rehearsal are:

- Members loaning a university instrument to alumni band members.
- Derbies
- Legacies (members performing Bulldog March Medley with family members on the field for alumni band)

Saturday Schedule:

0600- Alumni call time for check-in, walkups, shirts, etc.

Redcoats, Derbies, and Legacies either performing or loaning instruments to be at Redcoat Field at 0640 hrs.

0700- Alumni rehearsal begins

0830- Rehearsal ends, proceed to shuttle buses by Deck for transport to Stadium

0850- Buses depart for Stadium

Brett and John Cypert will decide the location for those signed up for large brass and percussion loans to meet with Redcoats for swap. Large brass as always will be sanitized at practice and at stadium each time that instrument changes hands. Megan Williams and others designated will facilitate that process and check instruments off; she will communicate details when decided by Staff to those students and alumni borrowing. It may be the NW corner gate by the RBAA lower-level seating block 102), tunnel, or at the bottom of the Redcoat Band block in Section 112.

Alumni Band performers will be granted access by Security to sidelines with 6:00 remaining on the 2nd Qtr. clock. Approved uniform for the day and RBAA 2026 field pass required to enter field. Perform halftime to the South side, and **immediately must exit field upon conclusion.** Borrowed instruments disinfected and returned to same location- return to seats and enjoy the rest of the game!
