



2026 REDCOAT ALUMNI BAND DAY FACT SHEET

(Updated 08-29-26)

Performing HALFTIME (NOT Pregame) Sat. Sept. 12 vs. Western Kentucky. 12:30 broadcast on the SEC Network with 12:45 kickoff time. Free parking will be available in the Intramural Fields parking deck, Lot S-26, possibly Field #8 (subject to availability and weather conditions).

Call time is 6:00 am at Redcoat Field; downbeat for rehearsal is 7:00. Breakfast will NOT be provided this year, so please grab a “breakfast bar” beforehand. Please be prompt, as check-in will include white shirt distribution, borrowed large brass and percussion (if reserved prior to registration close) and other tasks. Rehearsal concludes at 8:30 and shuttle buses will depart from the IM Deck at 8:50 for the Stadium.

Tickets purchased through the RBAA have all been transferred. Be sure to save to your Apple Wallet or Google Pay to be scanned at the gates. ALL entering the stadium must have a digital ticket on your phones (even babies).

Concessions inside Sanford are cashless, so don't forget a credit card if you wish to make any purchases.

Alumni Band musicians have been granted permission to wear BLACK shorts if you prefer that instead of long black pants (**NOTE**: Auxiliaries will continue with guidance from Ashley and Amanda regarding colors of clothing below the waist). Shorts **MUST** be tasteful and a conservative length (think mid-thigh). Any deviations of this dress code may result in refusal by security to enter the field for halftime. Socks and footwear must be black. You

might want to wear your red RBAA polo and change when you get your white t-shirt; the white shirts must be worn for the halftime performance. 2026 field passes must also be displayed (issued at check-in). NOTE: The white shirts are being provided for musicians and auxiliaries by UGA Athletics so that all can participate in the WHITEOUT! UGA Athletics is also providing white shirts for the Redcoat Band.

We welcome walkups! However, remember that there is a limited number of shirts and field passes. No large brass or percussion loaners are available to walkups.

Handicapped seating, if needed, must be handled directly by you with the Ticket Office AFTER you get your tickets:
